



## Habitat Lunch Donor Information

Thank you for your interest in donating lunch for Cape Fear Habitat's construction volunteers!

The mission of Habitat for Humanity could not advance without the generosity of dedicated members of the community like you! By providing lunch for our build site, you will be making a huge difference and impact on Habitat. Every role at Habitat is significant and lunch is no exception. A lunch provided to our volunteers shows our appreciation for their efforts and helps fuel the incredible work that is done on site.

If you are interested in donating lunch, below is some brief information on how it works:

We typically break for lunch around 11:30 a.m, so it is best to arrive a little bit before then so lunch can be set up. Habitat's Volunteer Coordinator will confirm the number of volunteer lunches needed the week prior to your scheduled lunch donation day.

The volunteers on site will include the volunteers from the community, Habitat homeowners who will be working "sweat equity" on site, as well as our construction site supervisors.

We ask that you provide physical lunches and bring them to site. Examples of lunches include: a tray of sandwiches and chips, pizza, barbeque, hot dogs and hamburgers, and anything else that is easy to eat on site. If you have any questions on potential items for lunch, please ask Habitat's Volunteer Coordinator and he will advise you.

Please ensure that you provide all necessary paper products (plates, napkins, utensils, and cups). In addition, we ask that you bring drinks, such as soft drinks and sports drinks.

When it is time for lunch, we will gather around the food and we will recognize the generous lunch donor who made it possible for our volunteers to have a great experience, YOU! We will then say a blessing over the food, which sometimes is done by our lunch donor. Just let us know if you would like to do so.
